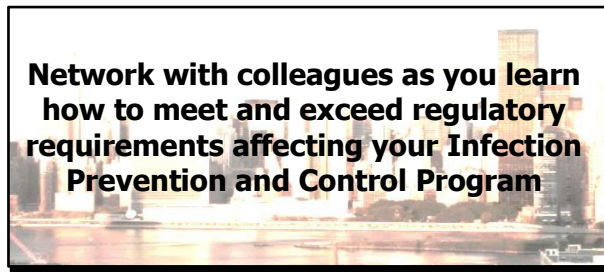
Program Goals
