Conduct day-to-day surveillance of hospital-wide infection prevention activities to identify and report infections related to CMS' Hospital Acquire Conditions prevention and Value Based Purchasing criteria (central line-associated bloodstream infections, catheter-associated urinary tract infections, SSIs and other indicators) using standard definitions (DCD/NHSN criteria); assist in regulatory/survey readiness in compliance with Joint Commission, NYS Department of Health and CMS standards; Act as facilitator and consultant to decrease risk of infection within the hospital and its associated clinics; Note trending of antibiotic resistance patterns and implement appropriate special precautions when resistance is identified; Serve on task forces and committees to provide infection control expertise and assistance; Work with Occupational Health Service to ensure medical follow up of exposures; Perform other duties as assigned.

### Minimum Qualifications

- A Baccalaureate Degree from an accredited college or university in Public Health, Public Administration, Business Administration, Social Work, Psychology or Rehabilitation Counseling, and three (3) years of full-time experience in
